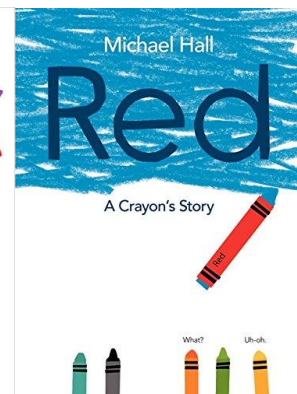
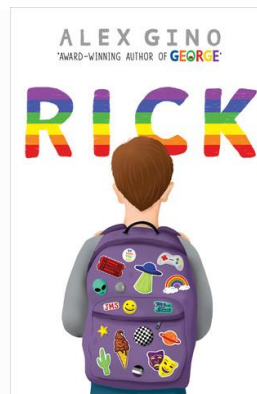
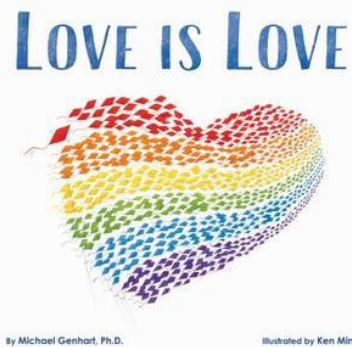
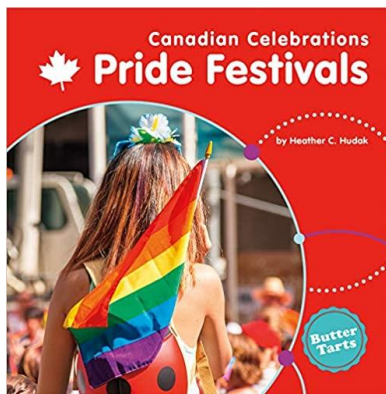


# A book list to celebrate PRIDE (year-round) – fiction & non-fiction for all ages

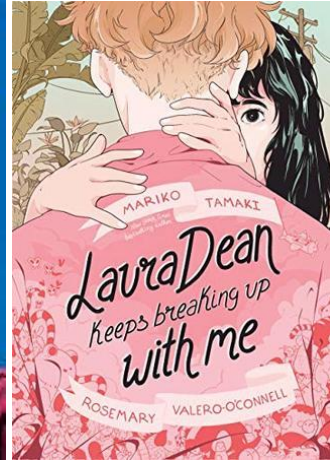
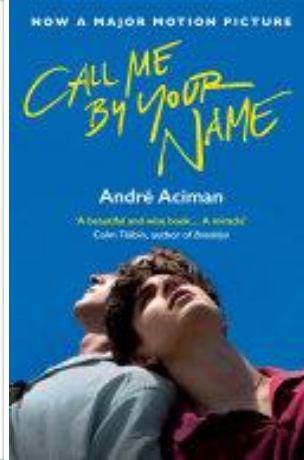
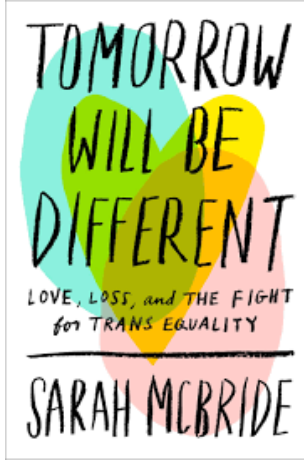
