

# Other Snowshoe Activities

Finished your scavenger hunt? Try out these other winter activities!

#### 1. Look for animal tracks

How many different types of animal tracks can you spot? We have animal track identification books available to help you identify them!

### 2. Leave a snow message

Write a nice message in the snow for the next person!

### 3. Hug a tree

Can you find a tree with the perfect circumference to fit your arms all the way around?

You can estimate how old a tree is by measuring the circumference. 2.5 cm = approximately 1 year of growth!

## 4. Play Camouflage

One person calls "Camouflage" covers their eyes, and slowly counts to 10. Everyone else runs and hides so that they can still see the Caller, but the Caller can't see them - use your camouflage! Without moving, the Caller has to try and spot everyone who is hiding. The last person spotted is the next Caller, and can shout "Camouflage" at any point in the walk.
